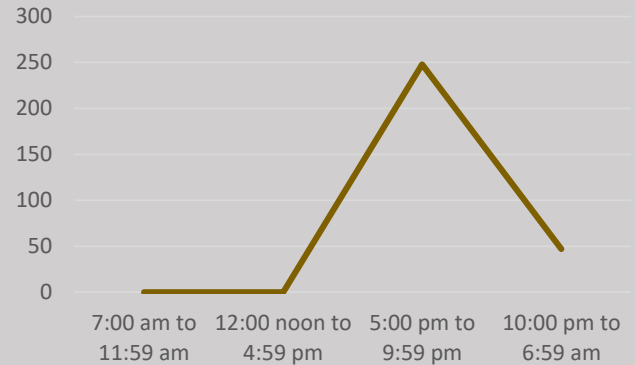

### Total # of Client Visits in July: 295

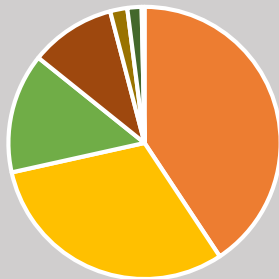
The OPS is part of an overall harm reduction strategy – connecting people to the services they need when and where they need them. Since opening the OPS in June there was an increase in people accessing harm reduction supplies and information.

**308** people who access Hamilton Urban Core services also received harm reduction supplies and information and an additional **98** people directly connected to the OPS also accessed harm reduction materials.

#### # of Visits to OPS in July by Time of Day

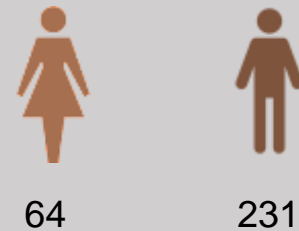


#### # of Clients Consuming by Substance
