

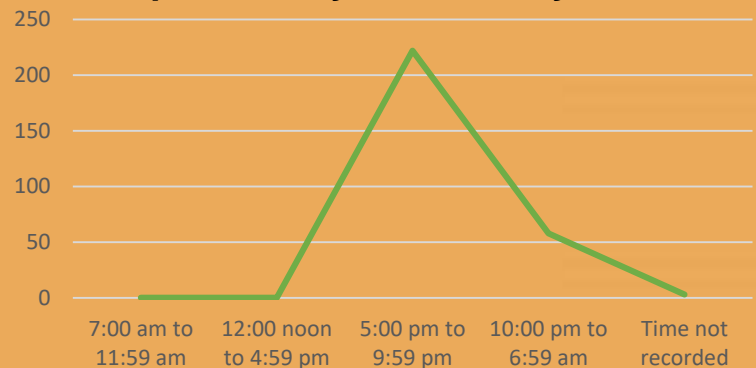
Overdose Prevention Site

September 2018

Total # of Client Visits in September: 426

The OPS is part of an overall harm reduction strategy – connecting people to the services they need when and where they need them. In September there was **426** visits to the OPS. Of those there was **62** visits by people under age **25**, **354** visits by people between **25** and **64** years old, **1** visit by an individual over **65** years of age and **9** visits from people who did not identify their age.
