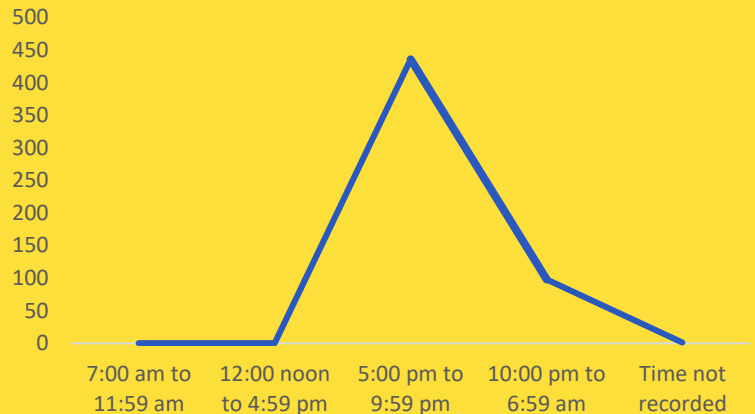
**Total # of Client Visits in November: 535**

The OPS is part of an overall harm reduction strategy– connecting people to the services they need when and where they need them.



In November there was **123** visits by people under age **25**, and **406** visits by people between the ages of **25** and **64**; and **6** visits by people whose age is unknown

### How are we doing?

- # of overdoses requiring oxygen/rescue breathing: **5**
- # of overdoses requiring treatment of naloxone: **1**
- # of doses of naloxone administered: **1**
- # of calls to EMS related to overdose: **0**
- # of deaths occurring at the OPS: **0**
