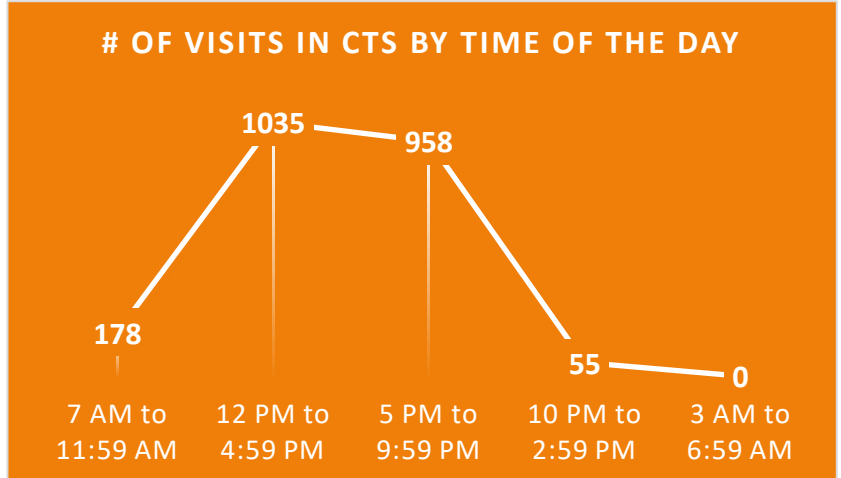

Total # of Client Visits in November: 2,226

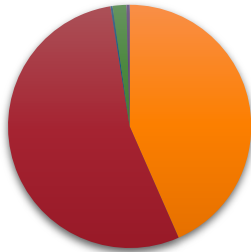
The CTS is part of an overall harm reduction strategy— connecting people to the services they need, when and where they need them.



In November **4** people under age 25 visited the CTS, and **169** individuals between the ages of **25** and **64** visited the CTS and **1** person over the age of **65** used the service.

How are we doing?

- Total # of overdoses: **16**
- # of overdoses requiring solely oxygen/rescue breathing: **6**
- # of overdoses requiring treatment of naloxone: **10**
- # of doses of naloxone administered: **13.5**
- # of calls to EMS related to overdose: **2**
- # of transfers to an emergency department related to an overdose: **2**
- # of deaths occurring at the CTS: **0**
