
Consumption and Treatment Service January 2020

Total # of Client Visits in January: 2,569

The CTS is part of an overall harm reduction strategy– connecting people to the services they need, when and where they need them.



In January, 8 people under the age of 25 visited the CTS, and 219 individuals between the ages of 25 and 64 visited the CTS.1 person over the age of 65 used the service.

of overdoses requiring solely oxygen/rescue breathing: 12


