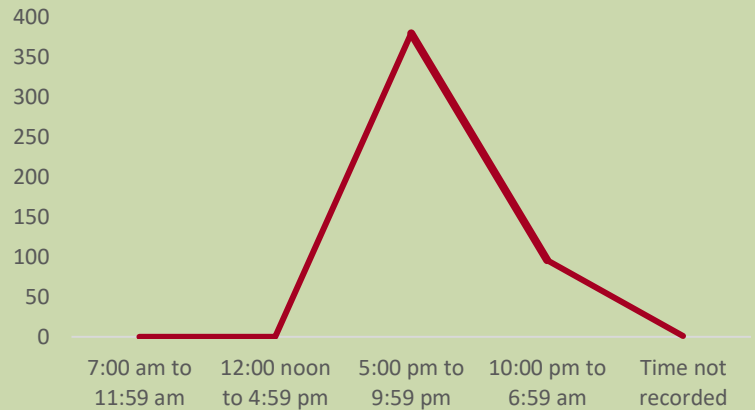
Total # of Client Visits in January: **458**

How are we doing?

- # of overdoses requiring oxygen/rescue breathing: **4**
- # of overdoses requiring treatment of naloxone: **2**
- # of doses of naloxone administered: **4**
- # of calls to EMS related to overdose: **0**
- # of deaths occurring at the OPS: **0**
