

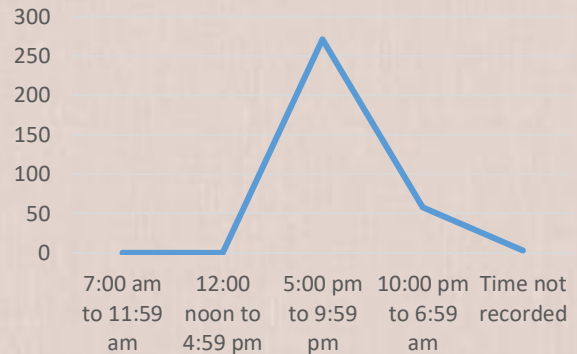

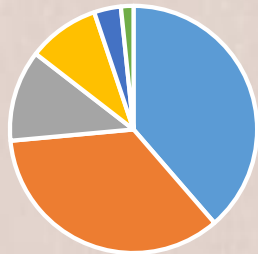
Total # of Client Visits in August: 332

The OPS is part of an overall harm reduction strategy – connecting people to the services they need when and where they need them. In August there was **332** visits to the OPS. Of those there was **52** visits by people under age **25**, **276** visits by people between **25** and **64** years old, **1** visit by an individual over **65** years of age and **3** visits from people who did not identify their age.

of Visits to OPS in August by Time of Day

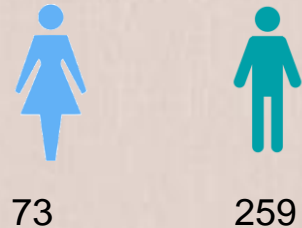


of Clients Consuming Substances
