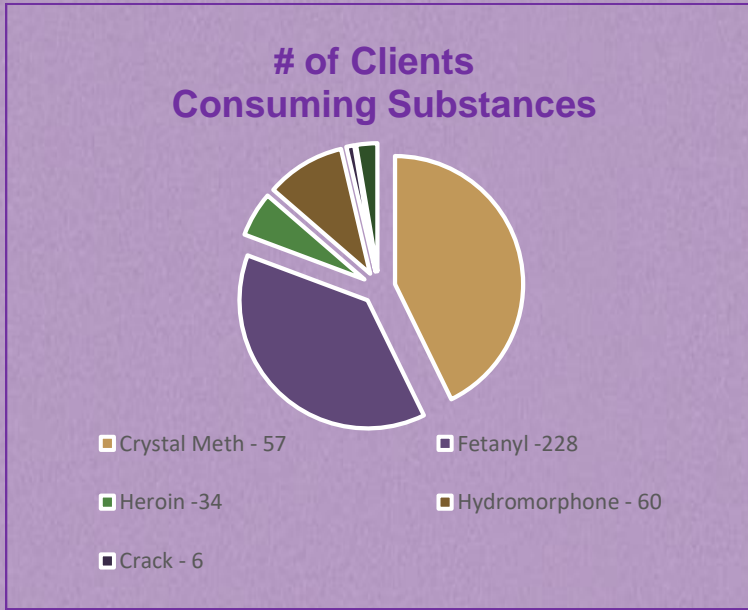
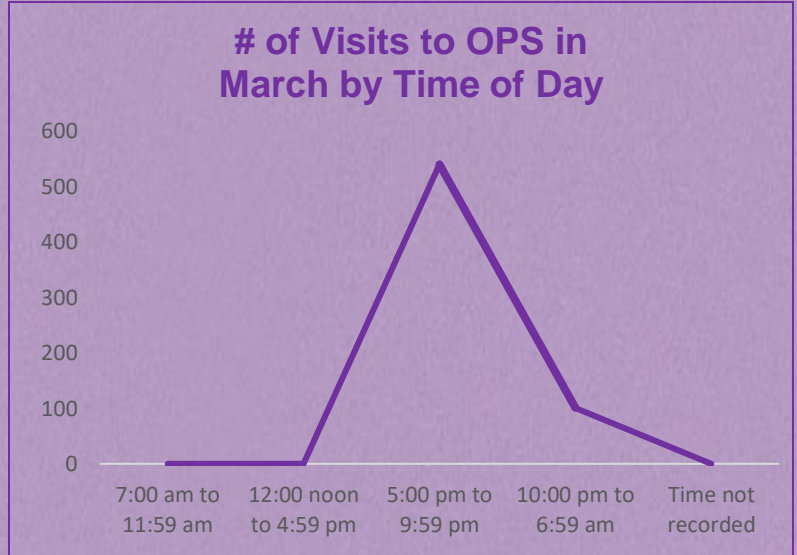

Total # of Client Visits in March: 641

The OPS is part of an overall harm reduction strategy— connecting people to the services they need, when and where they need them.



In March there was **36** visits by people under age **25**, and **600** visits by people between the ages of **25** and **64**, **4** visits by people over the age of **65** and **1** person whose age is unknown

How are we doing?

- # of overdoses requiring oxygen/rescue breathing: **9**
- # of overdoses requiring treatment of naloxone: **5**
- # of doses of naloxone administered: **7**
- # of calls to EMS related to overdose: **1**
- # of transfers to an emergency department related to an overdose: **1**
- # of deaths occurring at the OPS: **0**
