The OPS is part of an overall harm reduction strategy— connecting people to the services they need, when and where they need them.

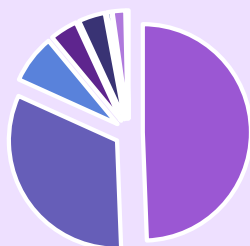


In December there was **120** visits by people under age **25**, and **434** visits by people between the ages of **25** and **64**; and **4** visits by people whose age is unknown

### How are we doing?

- # of overdoses requiring oxygen/rescue breathing: **3**
- # of overdoses requiring treatment of naloxone: **2**
- # of doses of naloxone administered: **3**
- # of calls to EMS related to overdose: **1**
- # of deaths occurring at the OPS: **0**
