Finding a Location

A search was conducted to determine the best location for HUCCHC to move to. Out of five different locations, 430 Cannon St. was deemed to be the most suitable location due to its functional ability to meet the different needs of the community needs we serve.

Why 430 Cannon St. E?

As an inner city Community Health Centre, serving Hamilton for over 25 years. Hamilton Urban Core CHC strives to address the health inequities faced by our community members, neighbours, friends and family, such as poverty, racism, discrimination, unemployment, and homelessness. Our new location at 430 Cannon St. E is within our catchment area of the population that we serve.

Soil Remediation

Multiple soil testing's have been completed at the new location on June 2017 & July 2017. The former owner removed the fuel storage tanks and provided a "Removal of Underground Fuel Storage Tank and Remediation Report" completed by Terraprobe Inc. in June 2017.

ESA Phase one and Phase two were completed prior to the demolition of the site. A record of site condition is underway.

Bike Parking

Bike parking will be available. The Transportation Demand Measures are currently in review, including bike parking. However, with the current plan, the future location is meeting Zoning By-Law Requirements.
