What is Safer Supply?

Safer Supply programs provide People Who Use Drugs with a prescribed, regulated alternative medication to the toxic street supply.

Why Safer Supply?

Between January and October 2023, Hamilton Paramedics responded to 836 incidents related to suspected opioid overdoses.

Opioid deaths are increasing annually in Hamilton

In 2022, there were 163 deaths in Hamilton, related to opioid use.

Benefits of Safer Supply

In addition to reduction in overdose rates, research demonstrates:

- Improvements in health and social well-being
- Increased access to health and social supports
- Reductions in police and criminal justice system involvement
- Improved relationships with family members and friends
