As an inner-city health centre our client populations include individuals and families with chronic and complex health and social conditions, many of who are living in poverty.

The Registered Practical Nurse (RPN) functions as a member of the Prescribed Alternatives & Outreach Program (PAO) formerly known as Hamilton Urban Safer Supply (HUSS) team in the provision of harm reduction services to clients that access the PAO team in the provision of harm reduction services to clients that access the PAO, with a strong emphasis on disease prevention and health promotion. Working primarily with the Centre's priority populations, the RPN will provide primary health care services in addition to participating in the development, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of services for individuals who use drugs.

The RPN will be responsible for ensuring that clients are connected to support and treatment services through Hamilton Urban Core, partners, and community agencies. Our office is fully compliant with all COVID-19 protocols.
